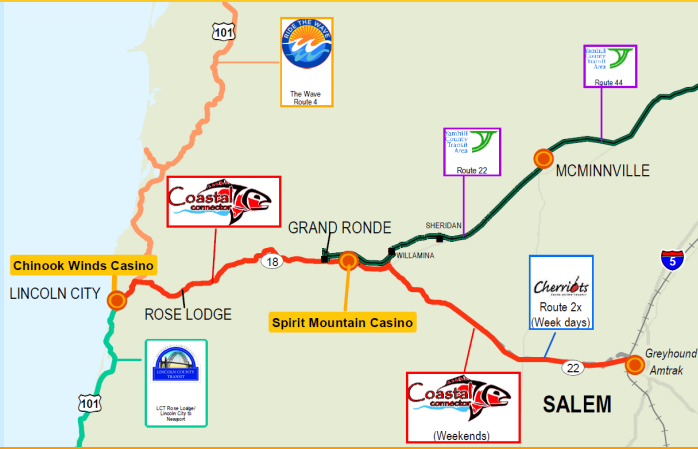

Be Driven

The Coastal Connector links: Lincoln City/ Chinook Winds Casino and Rose Lodge to Grand Ronde on a daily basis. At Spirit Mountain Casino on weekdays you can transfer to Cherriots 2X route to Salem. On weekends Coastal Connector continues on to Salem. Connections in Salem can get you to Greyhound, Amtrak and other travel options.

At Spirit Mountain Casino Monday through Saturday you can transfer to Yamhill County Transit Area's West Valley Route 22 to Willamina, Sheridan and McMinnville. From there connections can be made to MAX in Hillsboro. Connections to Newberg, Sherwood, Tri-Met and WES in Tigard.

From Lincoln City there are connections through the North by Northwest Connector  linking coastal communities north to Tillamook, Cannon Beach, Astoria and south to Depoe Bay, Newport, Yachats.

parking

Long term parking at the following locations:

- Chinook Winds (near bus stop)
- Grand Ronde campus near community center
- Spirit Mountain east side of casino
- Salem Railroad Station (if spaces are available)

bike racks

Buses are equipped with a 2-place bike rack. Signal the driver that you will be loading a bike then follow the 3 step process illustrated on the rack at the front of the bus. For safety, drivers may refuse any bike that cannot be loaded properly. Loading is solely the rider's responsibility.

fares

One way Fare:

Between Lincoln City & Grand Ronde: \$3.00
Between Grand Ronde & Salem: \$3.00

Weekend Full Fare:

Between Lincoln City & Salem: \$6.00

Reduced Fares:

0-5 years old with paying adult:

First Child..... Free
Additional Children..... ½ fare

6-18 years old½ fare

60 & older / or disabled.....½ fare

Drivers accept cash only for exact fare.

transfers

- Weekdays: Cherriots 2X Route between Grand Ronde and Salem: \$3.00 (\$1.50 ADA/youth).
- Monday-Saturday: YCTA West Valley Route to Willamina/Sheridan/McMinnville: \$1.25.
- Lincoln City loop daily rides: \$1.00 per zone.
- Lincoln City to Tillamook: \$4.50.

Service Exceptions:

- No Service New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day.
- (Cherriots doesn't operate on Veterans Day or Presidents Day. Coastal Connector will operate weekend service schedule to Salem those days).

Reservations are recommended near holidays.
Availability of seating is not guaranteed. School group trips are limited to capacity.

traveling on the Coast

The North by Northwest CONNECTOR links coastal communities from Astoria to Yachats! Look for the Connector  at major bus stops and transfer points along US 101, or ask your driver for the best way to connect.

what's the cost?

While it's possible to pay individual fares for each bus route, we recommend a 3-day or 7-day visitor pass. These passes may be purchased directly from the Connector drivers and are good for one trip to the coast from Portland, Salem or the Albany/Corvallis area, one return trip, and unlimited travel in Clatsop, Tillamook and Lincoln Counties (from Astoria to Yachats).

visitor passes

3 Day Pass is \$25.00

7 Day Pass is \$30.00

Drivers accept cash only for exact fare.

rider info

You must conduct yourself in a manner that does not interfere with the safety & comfort of other passengers. Disruptive behavior, profanity or vulgar language may result in removal from the bus.

- No smoking or eating is allowed on the bus. Drinks allowed in driver approved container only.
- For your safety, seatbelts are provided and recommended.
- Space is limited; each rider is allowed up to 3 bags and must be able to manage them.
- Luggage must be stowed in designated areas.
- Radio/tape/CD/game player may only be used with earphones.
- For safety reasons, please refrain from unnecessary conversations with driver.
- Arrive at bus stops at least 5 minutes before scheduled time.
- When departing the bus, please be sure to gather all your carried on items. Wait for the bus to pull away before crossing the street to ensure traffic is clear.
- If you find a lost item, give it to the driver. If you lose an item, call the office. Unclaimed items may be disposed of after 30 days.

Tillamook County Transportation District, Salem -Keizer Transit District and Yamhill County Transit assume no liability for lost or stolen belongings, missed reservations or missed connections. All tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Service Animals: Are always welcome. Pets must travel in a driver approved pet carrier and present no health or safety risk. Owners must control their animals at all times while riding.
