Pacific Transit storm prep  
Weather forces more route changes

Nov. 6—Pacific Transit System braces for stormy weather with schedule changes, including elimination of the 12:30 p.m. Purple run from South Bend to Ilwaco.

High winds and king tides are predicted to be even worse than Wednesday.

Pacific Transit has adjusted schedules on some routes today in anticipation of the storm and may be forced to make further changes during the day if flooding or road conditions dictate.

US 101 in Raymond by the Thriftway shopping center is vulnerable to flooding. High tide for Raymond is at 1:10 p.m.

The following routes are affected today:

- Purple (South Bend to Ilwaco): The bus will make its morning run at 9:40 a.m. and WILL NOT RUN AGAIN until the final 3:30 p.m. run.
- Blue (Ilwaco to Astoria): The bus will make its last morning run at 9 a.m. and WILL NOT RUN AGAIN until the final 4:30 p.m. run.
- Green (Raymond to Aberdeen): The bus will make its last morning run at 9:30 a.m. and WILL NOT RUN AGAIN until a final 5:00 p.m. run (*Note: This is later than the usual final run of the day*).
