SUNSET EMPIRE TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT SEEKS TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The Sunset Empire Transportation District (SETD) is seeking volunteers from Clatsop County to serve on its Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC). The TAC is comprised of five to nine members who provide advice and recommendations to the SETD Board of Commissioners on transportation-related plans, grants, policies, and programs, with particular emphasis on accessibility for senior and disabled riders. TAC members represent community perspectives and help ensure that SETD services are equitable, responsive, and aligned with public transportation needs.

Oregon state guidelines require that the TAC include representation of low-income individuals, the disabled community, the senior community and a public transportation provider. Local governments, employers, transit users, human service providers, social equity advocates, environmental advocates, bicycle and pedestrian advocates, and educational institutions can also be represented on the TAC.

Applications must be received by NOON January 19, 2026.

Applications will be reviewed by the board. Applicants are required to attend SETD Board of Commissioners meeting, 9A to noon, on Thursday, January 22, 2026 at the Astoria Transit Center when interviews and selection of TAC members will take place.

"This committee is more than a voice for their communities—they are essential to our shared vision, helping guide priorities and ensure our planning reflects the needs and aspirations of the people we serve."
